

Community Update Announcement April 4, 2020

As you are aware, these are the steps that are being taken in response to COVID 19 Pandemic:

- A letter has been sent to the Minister of Defense, a joint initiative with Cross Lake, for military help for both communities
- There are a group of men who are harvesting wild food and will be distributed to the community – fish has been given out to each household and who are continuing their deliveries, goose and duck hunting will also be done when weather permits
- Turkeys will be given out before Easter weekend for each household
- For the road block, which is located at Pine Creek, only community members will be allowed in and everyone who returning to the community must self isolate passes will be given out to monitor who leaves the community for essential reasons (Medical, hunting, fishing, ferry operators, PDC)
- The York Boat Inn is currently being used for people who need to self- isolate and meals will be provided.
- All recommendations are being considered and there are daily meetings taking place
- At this time, there will be more enforcement regarding selfisolation and if there is non-compliance, they will be forced to mandatory quarantine at any of the identified locations
- Effective today, April 4, 2020, there will be a community curfew in effect from 12:00am-6am, No one should be out after 12:00am
