

Effective May 4, 2020

Phase 1 - Relaxing Restrictions

- Essential travel restrictions for both north and south of 53 remain with exceptions.
 Passes are still required to leave Norway House.
- 2) All essential travel within the north shall self-monitor only for symptoms of COVID-19.
- Self-monitoring will be supported by term employees from the NHCN Public Health who will call patients every 4 days for a total of 3 calls to inquire about any symptoms.
- 4) People who travelled or are returning outside of northern Manitoba and/or outside of the province will be required to self-isolate for 14 days at home and safe practices be implemented. If own room and washroom is not available in the house, person(s) can be accommodated at the specific location set up by PAT.
- 5) Gym and Multiplex will remain closed.
- 6) Curfew between 12:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. remains.
- 7) Public gatherings such as social gatherings, worship, weddings, and funerals shall remain at maximum of 10.
- 8) Public food establishments, such as restaurants will remain closed, except for delivery or take out
- 9) Food sales will be approved through Quarantine Officer

All other safe measures remain in place – physical distancing of two meters, hand sanitizing/washing.
